Former Judge Becomes Orange Housing Authority Development Corporation Board Member

ORANGE, NJ -The Orange Housing Development Corporation (OHDC) swore-in Judge Harold Fullilove on August 9, 2011 during a special meeting called by Walter McNeil, Ph.D., OHDC, President. After a 9 month search, Judge Fullilove was selected to join the 9 member organization that is responsible for overseeing the construction and development of the Walter G. Alexander Village Development.

The Orange Housing Development Corporation was formed in April 2008, as a measure to address the vast affordable housing concerns.
