

INVITATION TO BID

HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ORANGE

Bid Notice Date: December 9, 2019

Notice is hereby given that the Housing Authority of the City of Orange, New Jersey, will accept sealed bids until **2:30 p.m. (local time), Friday, January 3, 2010,** for the following project:

**Furnish and Install New Automatic Sliding Entrance Doors and Associated Components at, Washington Manor Building

Bids will be accepted by mail or in person until 2:30 p.m., prevailing time on, **Friday, January 3, 2010.** Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at 2:35 p.m., on **Friday, January 3, 2010,** at the Conference Room in the offices of the Housing Authority of the City of Orange, located at 340 Thomas Boulevard, Orange, New Jersey 07050,

Bids are invited for all supervision, labor, materials, equipment, delivery, and services concerning the work. All work is as shown on the drawings entitled **Housing Authority of the City of Orange: Furnish and Install New Automatic Sliding Entrance Doors and Associated Components at, Washington Manor Building, 340 Thomas Boulevard Orange, New Jersey** and as detailed in the construction specifications. Bids must be made on Proposal Form furnished; in the manner designated, and the envelope containing the bid shall be endorsed on its face with the name of the person, firm or corporation making such proposal and **"Sealed Bid: Furnish and Install New Automatic Sliding Entrance Doors and Associated Components at, Washington Manor Building, 340 Thomas Boulevard Orange, New Jersey ,"** Please submit one (1) original and three (3) copies of the proposal. The Authority will consider all bids properly submitted at its scheduled Bid Opening.

Copies of the bid documents may be obtained upon **non-refundable payment of \$100.00** per set of drawings and specifications (one (1) set of specifications, one (1) set of drawings) at the Office of Housing Authority of the City of Orange, located at 340 Thomas Boulevard, Orange, New Jersey 07050, beginning on December 9, 2019 **between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** Payment shall be in the form of certified check or bank draft, payable to the Housing Authority of the City of Orange.

Bid proposals must be accompanied by bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check, drawn to the order of the Housing Authority of the City of Orange, in the amount of 10% of the bid. However, in no case shall this amount exceed twenty thousand (\$20,000.00) dollars.

Bidders must be registered pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34.11-56.48 State of New Jersey, Department of the Labor and Workforce Development, prior to the date that bids are accepted, showing eligibility for bidding on contract for public work and for engaging in the performance of public work. A copy of the current certificate of registration shall be submitted with the bid.

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:5:33, all bidders are placed on notice of contract compliance with the law against discrimination and related provisions of P.L. 1975, Chapter 127.

Corporate or partnerships bidders shall state names and addresses of stockholders or partner holding ten percent (10%) or more interest therein, in compliance with P.L. 1977, Chapter 33.

A **pre-bid meeting** will be held on **Tuesday, December 17, 2019 at 10:00 am** in the **Conference Room, located at 340 Thomas Boulevard, Orange, New Jersey 07050**. Proposed bidders are encouraged to attend this meeting to review the project site and job requirements, and to ask questions at that time regarding information in the construction documents.

The Housing Authority of the City of Orange shall be the sole judge of the bid and the resulting agreement that is in its best interest and its decision shall be final. All bidding and award procedures undertaken by the Authority in regard to this project shall be consistent with the Authority's adopted procurement procedures and with its rules and regulations. Bid prices shall remain in effect for 60 days after bid opening.

Upon contract award, bidder must furnish and deliver a performance/payment bond for 100 percent (100%) of the contract amount.
